This fall, William Morrow/An Imprint of HarperCollins will publish *Making Mischief: A Maurice Sendak Appreciation* and *Matchless, a Christmas Story*.

His adult novels, all published by HarperCollins, are *Wicked* (1995), praised by John Updike in *The New Yorker* as "an amazing novel"; *Confessions of an Ugly Stepsister* (1999); *Lost* (2001); *Mirror Mirror* (2003); *Son of a Witch* (2005); and *A Lion Among Men* (2008).

Wicked: The Musical celebrated its fifth-year anniversary in October 2008. Its four North American and three international companies have cumulatively grossed over \$1 billion and have been seen by over 12.5 million people worldwide.
